Imagine another drama. The devil and all his forces are accusing you of breaking the commandments. There are statements that you tell lies about others; that you don't always obey your parents; that you sometimes cheat in school; that you don't always pay attention as the Bible is read or the sermon is shared. All of the accusations are true! We are sinners, and we are always disobeying God and sinning against His Word.

As the accusations are being made, you get very frightened. You know that you deserve to be punished. What will happen? How will God punish you?

Jesus steps into our drama. Jesus faces the devil and all your accusers. Jesus says, "Yes, this person is guilty of everything you have said. However, when I went to the cross I took all of those sins with me. My blood shed on the cross washed all those sins away. I declare this person, not guilty and I free him from all punishment." Jesus, the Advocate, has spoken as your defense!

Jesus does more than free us, He claims us as His children. His response to the devil continues, "Because this is my child, I will protect and keep him as mine forever."

Jesus is the perfect Advocate. As Jesus' children, we can speak as His advocates. We can defend those who others may bully. Older students can be advocates for younger students. Teachers can be advocates for children. Our church can be advocates for the needy in our community.

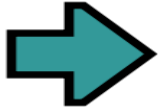
